NOTES ON FEES STRUCTURE

- All required Compulsory Fees together with outstanding fees owing by continuing students must be paid in full before the 18th February 2020.
- If you cannot pay full Board & Lodging fees for the year, you must pay seventy-five (75%) percent of the annual fees before the 18th February, 2020, with the remaining balance to paid by the 30th June, 2020.
- All Fees must be paid into the PNG University of Natural Resources & Environment’s Bank Account # 1000-688625 with Bank South Pacific, Kokopo Branch.

4. You must ensure that the Bank Teller inputs the student's name to appear on the bank statement, and the deposit slip must clearly show the student's name and Bank Account number. The deposit slip must be presented at the University's Accounts Section for an Official Receipt to be issued.
5. Non-payment of the required fees by the given deadline will deny completion of your registration formalities.
6. The increase in the 2020 fees by 5% accommodates the increases in prices of goods and services. Some fees have been reduced while those increased, were very minimal.
7. Medical Fee covers costs relating to basic clinical services provided by the University Clinic and any costs relating to procuring of other medical services.
8. Student Council Fee has been set by the Student Representative Council.
9. The same Library Fee is payable by all students whilst the Laptop Fee is only applicable to first year students.
10. Industrial Training Allowance covers second and third year students' work experience for six (6) weeks and three (3) months Industrial Training respectively.
11. The Insurance Fee has been reduced and it meets the costs of providing insurance cover for a student on an annual basis.
12. Annual Maintenance Fee covers any possible losses or damages to University property, a student may incur during the year.
13. Fees payable by a student on TESAS Scholarship may be adjusted subject to advice from the Department of Higher Education, Research, Science & Technology.
14. The University does not accept "Letters of Guarantee" as a means for a student to register. All Fees must be paid in full in order to register.
15. Any student who is not able to pay all applicable fees as stated above, must not come to PNG UNRE for studies in 2020. The University will not be responsible for the welfare of any student who turns up without paying the required fees, and is denied Registration and, Board & Lodging facilities on campus.

SOME IMPORTANT DATES

1. Students start arriving on the 19th February, 2020.
2. Orientation for new students will run from the 24th February, 2020 to the 28th February, 2020.
3. Registration for all students will be conducted as students arrive and will close on the 28th February, 2020.
4. Lectures for all students will begin on Monday 2nd March, 2020.
