3. <u>How to Enroll</u>



Need to improve your work performance and upgrade your qualifications? Self-employed and need to upgrade your management skills?

Each of us faces the paradox of today's globalised and interconnected world—how to balance two opposing forces—what we do and the need for change and renewal. The Masters in Management (MIM) course prepares you to embrace the interplay of these two forces as we strive for renewal and stability in our professional and work life.

PNGUNRE since the year 2000 has brought into the country eminent professionals at Doctorate and Professorial levels from well recognized overseas Universities to teach under its Postgraduate Studies Program. Both Papua New Guineans and expatriates living and working in the country have studied through this program and appreciate the international standard of teaching and assessments applied by the visiting Professors/Lecturers.

1. Study Options

UNRE offers a range of postgraduate courses that can be credited towards one of the following University of Natural Resources & Environment qualifications:

- Certificate of Attendance (short course format —per module basis)
- Post-Graduate Diploma in Management (4 core modules required)
- Masters in Management (Research) (8 modules required)

These are articulated, so that the credit from one program flows into the next in a step-wise manner. For students not wishing to study towards a UNRE qualification, you can enroll into a non-award program (short course type) without a need to sit for formal examination.

2. Learning Format

The format chosen is user-friendly and the courses are taught in flexible delivery mode. This model is ideal for participants employed full-time. The learning process is described below:

Participants receive their learning materials (including study guide) 4—6 weeks before lecture begins. This process enables them to have prior knowledge of the chosen topic. It also encourages them to start thinking on how it can be related to their real-life work situation.

Participants attend classes either online via zoom or inperson (face-to-face classes) in Kokopo for 1-2 weeks (8am – 5pm daily) intensive, but interactive and participative learning. At the beginning of the week, participants are introduced to relevant theories, concepts and contemporary practices relating to the module materials. As the week progresses, they apply this to their own work situations. And by the end, they develop an action plan to implement a learning project in their workplace or local community. They undertake this for a specified period, where they present their results and document their learning in a word assignment, which when submitted, forms part of formal assessment.

In order to gain credit, participants are required to sit for a formal examination or complete three assessments tasks for each of the modules.

A student not completing assessments for a module they attended can be issued a Certificate of Professional Development for that particular module or can repeat the module with full fees.

In the event that online/self study classes are conducted, three assessment tasks are given where the third assessment task replaces a formal examination. Eminent academic professionals from overseas universities conduct all lectures.
